IN THE NURSERY this morning our caregivers, Brenda Hall and helpers, will care for our youngest believers.

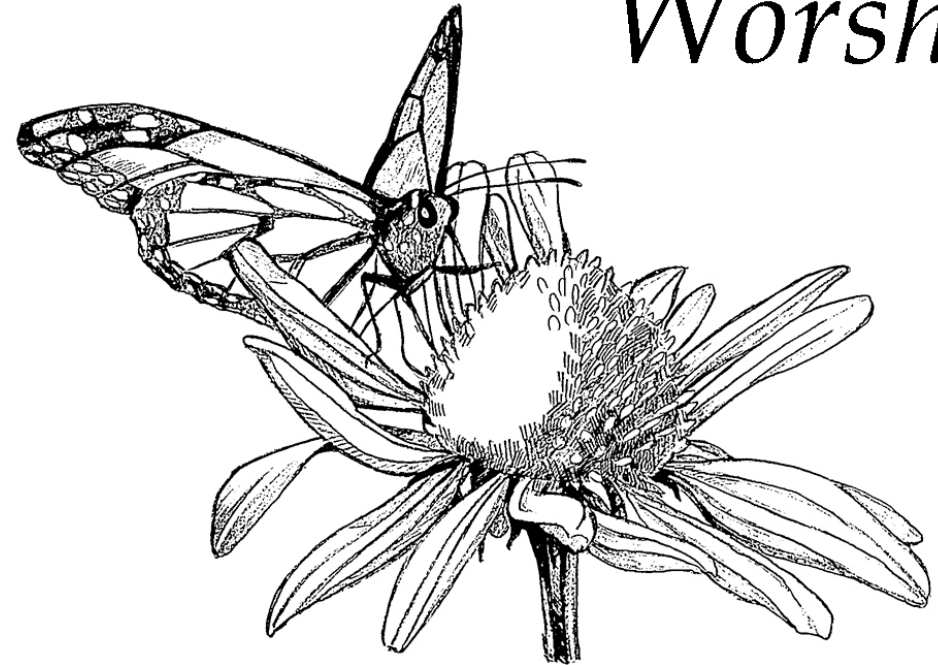
