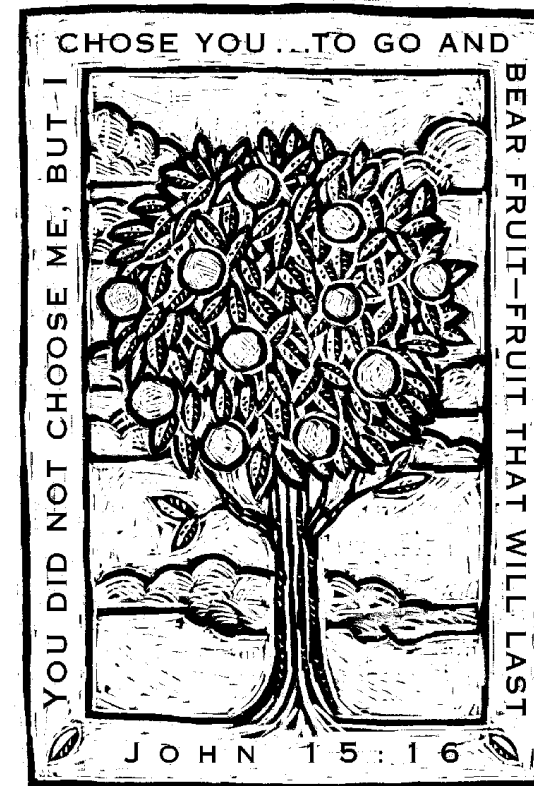
IN THE NURSERY this morning our caregivers, Brenda Hall, Tracy Plyler and Heather Gill, will care for our youngest believers.

YEAR OF THE BIBLE: Usually Paul starts his letters by calling himself a “servant.” This helps to emphasize his humility. What does he call himself in Galatians and what does this emphasize? (Gal. 1:1) What reason does God give for having not David, but Solomon, build a temple, or “house,” for God? (1 Chron. 22:8-9, 28:3) At Antioch, Paul confronts an important apostle who is avoiding eating with Gentile Christians because a group of Jewish Christians does not like the practice. Who is the apostle? (Gal. 2:11-13) What are some of the things that Paul list as examples of the “fruit” of the Spirit in a person’s life? (Gal. 5:22) These questions come from the readings for June 13-19.

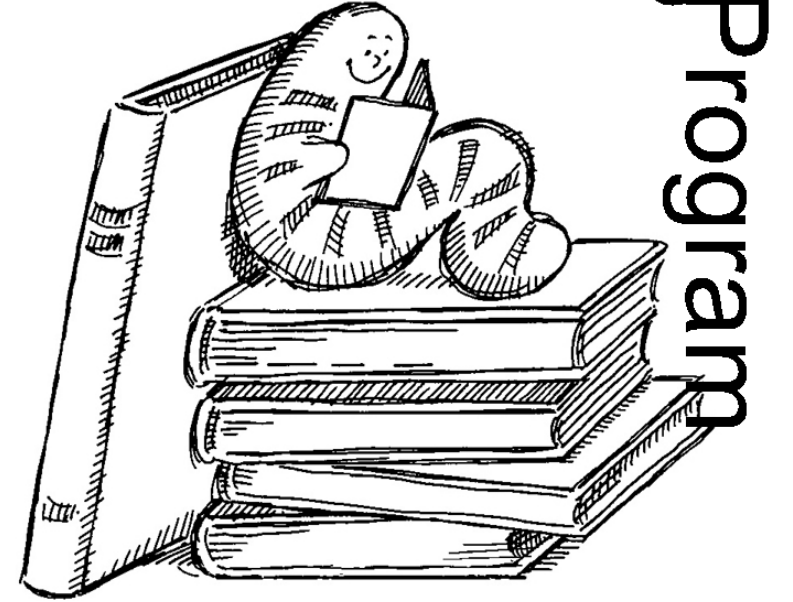

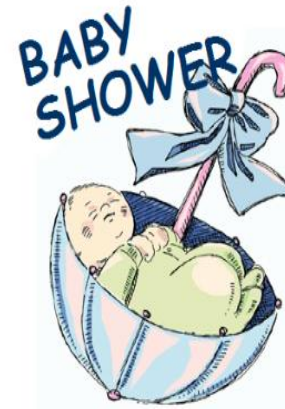
