IN THE NURSERY this morning our caregivers, Brenda Hall and Norma Pugh will care for our youngest believers.

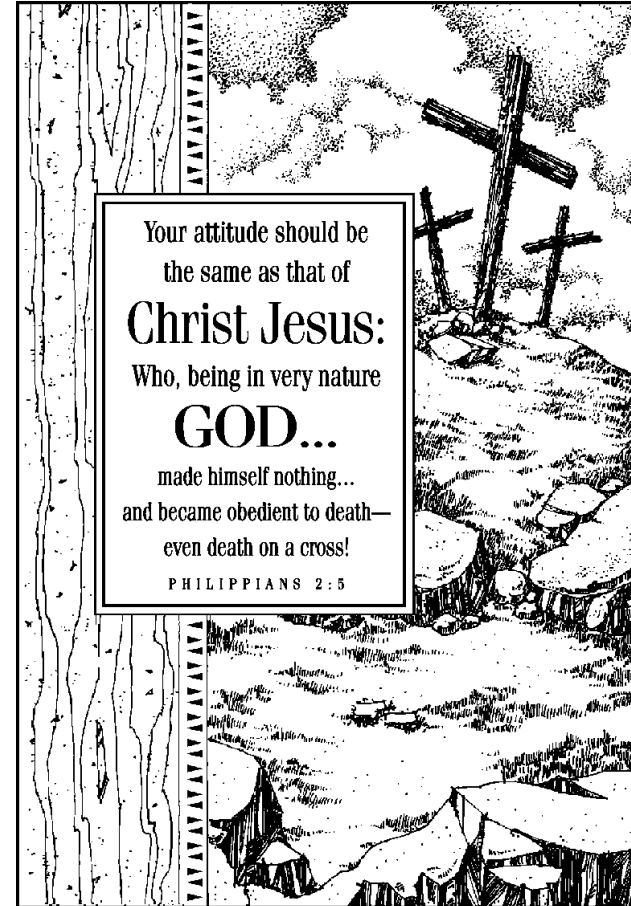
